Arabic 1:

Your goal is to be able to write Arabic letters and read the words by joining the letters. You are not expected to read phrases. Meaning of the words are not as important. You must focus on learning all letters and how they are written and read

Arabic 2:

You will focus on learning the 10 important reading rules using two books. These reading rules lay the foundation for recitation of Quran. You will also start reading short suraat towards the end of the class word-by-word, confirming that you applying each reading rule

Arabic 3 & Arabic 3 Advanced:

New Students and Current Arabic 3 students need to finish all Grammar Rules and apply them to finish Surah Baqarah verses 1 to 40 and Surah Faatihah, as well reading 5 lessons of Madinah book, all Quran Lessons and basics of Salaat and Dua so they understand

Advanced Students need to apply all grammar rules (plus Mudaaf, Adjectives and Mansoob/Marfoo) learnt so far to finish Surah Baqarah upto verse 100. They also need to wrap up lessons of Madinah book and start on Story of Prophet Ibraaheem (pbuh), basics of Salaat and Dua

Arabic 4:

We will cover new verses 100 - 150 but also review whole Juz 1 as well to confirm that you get some deeper meaning of the verses from Juz 1. New grammar rules will be taught along with Arabic 5

Arabic 5:

We will cover new verses 140 - 200 but also review whole Juz 1 as well to confirm that you get some deeper meaning of the verses from Juz 1. New grammar rules will be taught along with Arabic 4

Arabic 7:

Finish Juz 1 by reading/listening, half page English translation at a time and get Ijaazah. Discuss the vocabulary, Aqeedah and hadith goals in the class
